
Dear Mr. Falkiewicz:

The Department has reviewed the material you provided regarding EnviroLogic's Spillaway product line and how the Department would consider their use in oil spills and for routine cleanups of utility pole transformer releases. The Department finds no prohibition by State regulations for use of this product on surficial soils, as long it is applied in a manner consistent with the manufacturers instructions, and where PCB concentrations are known to be, or proven to be, less than 50 parts per million and, additionally, where runoff from the site will not discharge into waters of the State.

Use of the products for treatment of deep soils and/or groundwater is prohibited without first obtaining an Underground Injection Control permit from the Department.
